- Alexis is young and has her eyes on Ray's friend Scott in Charlotte. But she wants to take Ray for a test-drive first.
- Leslie is smart, ambitious and gorgeous. And alone. Maybe Ray can help.
- Jack and Dawn are swingers from Atlanta. Ray gets mixed up in some rough business.
- Alison is a smart, sexy black woman. She's single but.... Ray might be nice.
- Tara is looking for a little afternoon delight in a small town in Tennessee.
- Erica meets Ray down by the river.
- Nichole is a working girl at the Peabody Hotel in Memphis, TN. But she's a busy girl.
- Stacy lives with her mother but is looking for some hot action.

Ray is riding to get away from work for a while and to get to the truth about family lore. His grandfather built a Viking boat in Minnesota in the Sixties and sailed it down the Mississippi River with his son, Ray's father, when the boy was around 16. It was a coming of age trip, his father told him. But Ray never got the chance to make a trip like that with his father, or a son. So he sets out to test himself against the distance and the elements like his grandfather and father had. He is looking for an altar on the banks of the River, north of Memphis. His father always told him about the trip and that time on the banks of the Mississippi. But maybe his father didn't tell him the whole story. Ray is going to find out.

What Ray finds along the way are women who are dealing with the modern world: work, money, technology and family. Leslie owns a men's clothing store in Greenville,SC, the Seersucker Pavilion. Alison teaches ecology at UT-Chattanooga. Stacy works hard in Memphis. Tara runs an antique store in Lawrenceburg, TN and has an uncle who traveled the world as a radio newsman.

Sometimes he can help, other times not. Mostly he's a gentleman, but sometimes not.

This story twists and turns, meanders and wanders through the (mostly Southern) time and lives of women and men, blacks and whites, in big towns and small. There are a lot of stories along the way. Ray wants to hear them.

Spoiler Alert: he makes it to Memphis but what he finds is not what he expected. Special Note: the 12th woman is Jackie but she only appears when Monica hypnotizes Ray. I'm not sure if she's real or not. Ray sure thinks she is!
